

Relaxing Seaweed Bath: Sólás Na Mara Seaweed Baths Heilbhic, An Rinn, is a modern healthcare centre located in stunning coastal scenery close to Dungarvan. Romantic walk on the beach/Colligan woods: Dungarvan is a unique setting, with close proximity to coastal, mountain and woodland walks. Fall in love for the first time or all over again amongst some of the breathtaking scenery that Dungarvan has on its doorstep. Clonea Strand is located



approximately 5km outside Dungarvan and it holds an International Blue Flag award. This long, wide sandy beach provides fantastic views and a delightful scenic walk.

Tapas in the Tannery: For a truly special and memorable evening a visit to Paul Flynn's Tannery Restaurant is a real treat for the senses. Enjoy the atmospheric cosy surroundings, sample some wine from their comprehensive list and savour the delights of Paul's cooking.

The woodland of Colligan is situated 8km north of Dungarvan. With a recently laid out car park and riverside picnic tables it is a great place to head for a walk and picnic. The wood lies in a beautiful scenic valley through which the River Colligan flows. Access to the woodland is via a quaint wooden bridge. There are a variety of forest walks along the riverside and through the mixed woodland. Easy short walks can be enjoyed on either side of the picnic area whereas longer and more strenuous walks can be had by taking in the loop walk from the picnic site. The landscape here is beautiful whatever the season but it really comes into its own in the autumn when the leaves fall and settle on the ground in hues of gold, amber and russet.

Things to do in Gaeltacht na nDéise

The Irish speaking area Gaeltacht na nDéise is just down the road from Dungarvan. It is the last remaining Gaeltacht area on the eastern seaboard. The area consists of two parishes, An Rinn and An Sean Phobal and is spread across numerous townlands. About 1500 people call this Gaeltacht home with many using Irish as their primary language. Coupled with a passion for the native language, is a deep love of traditional music and dance, which transcends all age groups and gives a cultural vibrancy to the community which is held dear.

The parish of An Rinn provides a range of visitor services with two active harbours, Heilbhic (Helvick) and Baile na nGall and a number of beautiful beaches. The neighbouring parish of An Sean Phobal consists of a dramatic seascape comprising of cliffs (approximately 70m) together with a number of deeply incised stream gullies and small bays. The grassland along the cliffs attracts a wide variety of seabirds and is designated a special area of conservation. The area is a paradise for bird-watchers and people interested in nature.

Waterford Greenway

Rian Glas na nDéise

Waterford Greenway is a spectacular 46km cycling and walking trail along an old railway line which takes you from stunning Dungarvan all the way to the quays of Ireland's oldest city (Waterford). One of the best ways to explore the greenway is by bicycle and we are facilitated by The Greenway cycle tours and bike hire companies – see links below.

Dungarvan to Ballinroad (4km) – Open

This 4km stretch is simply fantastic. A gentle walk will take you from the Norman-founded market town of Dungarvan, along the glistening Dungarvan Bay, with King John's Castle behind you. Past Walton Park and the Moresby Buoy in Abbeyside which recognises the tragic sinking of the Moresby ship in 1895. Then on to the Barnawee Causeway, where many species of birds and sea life can be observed, before you reach the newly-constructed carpark in Ballinroad. A number of bike hire outlets will have you set up in minutes for an experience that will last long in your memory.

Ballinroad to Durrow (6km) - Open

Leave Ballinroad heading east, past the newly planted Irish native trees with the view to your left of the Old Clonea Church and its graveyard. It is said that Christian devotion was practiced here before St. Patrick arrived in Ireland and there is the legend of the skull-like stone. Heading past marshlands will take you to Clonea. The Atlantic Ocean is to your right; breathe in the salty sea air combined with the aroma of fresh local strawberries. Passing Clonea the trail then moves inland at Ballyvoile leaving magnificent views of Dungarvan bay and the Gaeltacht area of An Rinn (Ring) and Helvick across the inlet before proceeding. Next you cross the Ballyvoile Viaduct, beautifully restored by Waterford City & County Council, with the story of the viaduct embedded in some of the panels of the bridge. This leads you into an area of lush, almost tropical growth, before entering the quarter-mile Durrow Tunnel, with tasteful and discreet lighting keeping its magic and mystique alive. Continue on a little further to Durrow for a welcome break at O'Mahoney's Pub, where there is also a free car park available.

Durrow to Kilmacthomas Old Workhouse (13km) – Open

Only a few hundred metres beyond Durrow, you can find the lonely ruins of the Durrow and Stradbally Railway Station, a hive of activity in its heyday, now coming alive again. On another few hundred metres to Durrow Viaduct, another impressive stone bridge but what's unique about it is; it is a railway bridge over a road bridge over a river.



Heading through the lush countryside with the Comeragh mountains on the left, continue under the N25 at McGrath's Cross by means of a newly installed tunnel and it's onward for Kilmacthomas, crossing the impressive curved viaduct that can be really appreciated by coming down onto the path bringing you to the park below and viewing it from here. Kilmacthomas with its milling history and home to Flahavan's Porridge is making a big comeback with a powerful and highly driven local community ensuring that there will be a big welcome and plenty of facilities for the Greenway users. The river Mahon flows under this viaduct. Leaving Kilmacthomas you head past the ruins of the Kilmacthomas Railway Station recently taken over by the community to renovate into a welcoming station for visitors.

Travelling another kilometre and over the newly installed bridge across the N25 road, will bring you into the Old Workhouse of Kilmacthomas (also called 'The Union'). Here are a collection of interesting buildings, which in 1850 housed the destitute after the famine of the 1840's; recalling a sad but important history. There is also a large carpark here with bike hire available in the workhouse buildings and soon there will be a restaurant and a Workhouse Experience. Additionally, Mayfield Birds of Prey offers you an opportunity to meet, handle and fly a variety of wonderful birds, an interesting end to this stage of the Greenway.

There are various car parks located along the route, in Ballinroad, Durrow, Kilmacthomas - (Toilet Facilities) and Bilberry. When you are in the area you can call in to the Dungarvan Tourist Office for additional assistance and information.





Lunch Time Walks









DID YOU KNOW DUNGARVAN IS A 'SHARED SPACE'?

An Bhfuil A Fhios Agat Gur 'Spás Roinnte' É Dún Garbhán?

Shared Space is designed to minimise the segregation of pedestrians and vehicles. It is most readily recognized as a street space where all traffic control devices such as signals and stop signs, all markings such as crosswalks, and all signing have been removed. Curbing is removed to blur the lines between sidewalks and motorized travel way. The philosophy is that absence of all of those features forces all users of the space, from pedestrians to drivers, to be more aware and negotiate passage through the space via eye contact and person to person negotiation.

DUNGARVAN HAS BEEN AWARDED 'COACH FRIENDLY TOWN'

Bronnadh Stadas ' Baile Oiriúnach Do Chóistí' Ar Dhún Garbhán

Dungarvan is one of only 2 towns in Ireland to have successfully achieved the status of 'Coach Friendly Town'.
