EMPLOYER & WORKFORCE SUPPORTS

INTREO - WORK PLACEMENT EXPERIENCE PROGRAMME

The Work Placement Experience Programme allows employers to host a jobseeker on a work experience placement and to help the jobseeker to build new skills and gain valuable work experience. The programme is targeted at jobseekers who are on certain social welfare payments for 6 months (156 days) and want to avail of training & work experience to re-engage with the job market.

Employers who host a WPEP participant will provide a placement for 6 months with the participant attending for work experience for 30 hours a week.

There is no cost to the host /employer; the participant will be paid by the Department of Social Protection during their work placement, at a rate of €323 per week. No top-up payments to the participant are permitted.

INTREO - REDUNDANCY

If your business has to make employees redundant, Intreo can help your workers to plan ahead with:

- support to access new job opportunities, and
- advice on education and training opportunities.

If you can't afford to pay the statutory redundancy payment to employees, the Department of Social Protection can make a lump sum payment directly to the employees and then recover the debt from you through an agreed schedule of repayments.

JOBSPLUS

The **JobsPlus** scheme gives you incentives to hire someone who is unemployed.

If you employ someone who has been unemployed you may get a tax-free incentive of either €7,500 or €10,000 from the JobsPlus scheme. The money is paid monthly in arrears over a two-year period directly into your company's bank account. Applicants must meet the JobsPlus requirements such as working at least 30 hours a week. You can submit an online application.

- Jobseekers under 30 years of age may be eligible if unemployed for 4 months in the past 6 months.
- Jobseekers over 30 years of age may be eligible if unemployed for 12 months in the past 18 months.

Note: Time spent on the Covid-19 Pandemic Unemployment Payment (PUP) and Work Placement Experience Programme (WPEP) counts towards JobsPlus participant eligibility.

WAGE SUBSIDY SCHEME

The **Wage Subsidy Scheme** gives financial incentives to private sector employers to employ people with a disability. The work offered must be for a minimum of 21 hours per week and the subsidy is available up to 39 hours per week.

An employee with a disability on the scheme has the same conditions of employment as other employees.

TRAINING SUPPORT GRANT

The **Training Support Grant** is designed to fund quick access to short term training, obtain or renew certification and permits for individual jobseekers that have identified work opportunities or where Case Officers have identified an immediate skills gap that represents an obstacle to taking up a job offer.



BUSINESS SUPPORTS

LOCAL ENTERPRISE OFFICE

Local Enterprise Offices provide a range of complementary supports to support people who want to start up or grow a business.



The supports range from providing an initial "First Stop Shop" service where individuals can receive advice on the steps involved in setting up a business, to the provision of grants for feasibility studies, provision of financial support for the establishment of new businesses or expansion of existing ones and the provision of a range of soft supports such as training and mentoring.

Financial supports are available to qualifying businesses only, in the establishment and/or growth phase of their business and who employ up to ten people. Businesses operating in the domestic market (regardless of numbers employed) such as sole traders, micro businesses and small and medium sized companies may avail of the soft supports available from the Local Enterprise Office, such as First Stop Shop, Mentoring and/or Training programmes.

The range of supports is designed to assist businesses to grow by being able to provide targeted, and appropriate, assistance at each stage of their development. These supports are outlined in more detail in the following sections:

MICRO FINANCE IRELAND

Micro Finance Ireland provide small loans through the Government's Microenterprise Loan Fund. The purpose of the fund is to help start ups and established



businesses to get the finance they need for their business. What is a microenterprise? It is simply a small business (including a self-employed person) with fewer than 10 employees and an annual turnover of less than €2m. We help these businesses by providing unsecured business loans of €2,000 to €25,000 for commercially viable proposals. Sole Traders, Partnerships & Limited Companies are all eligible to apply.
